Fund objectives and investment policy

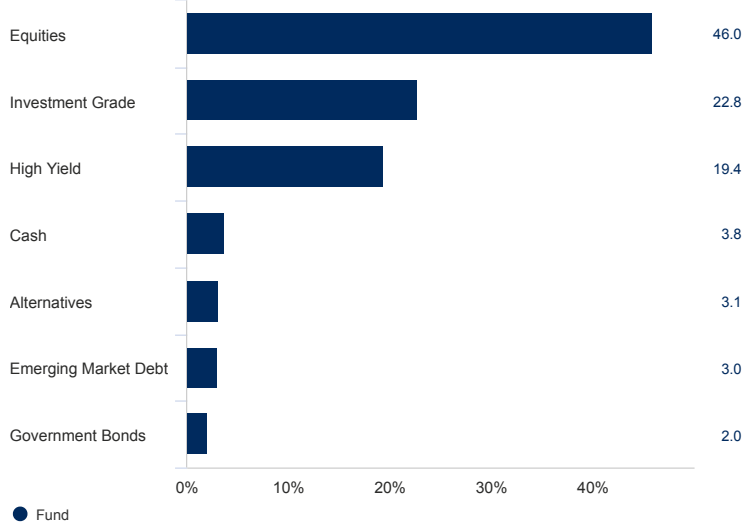

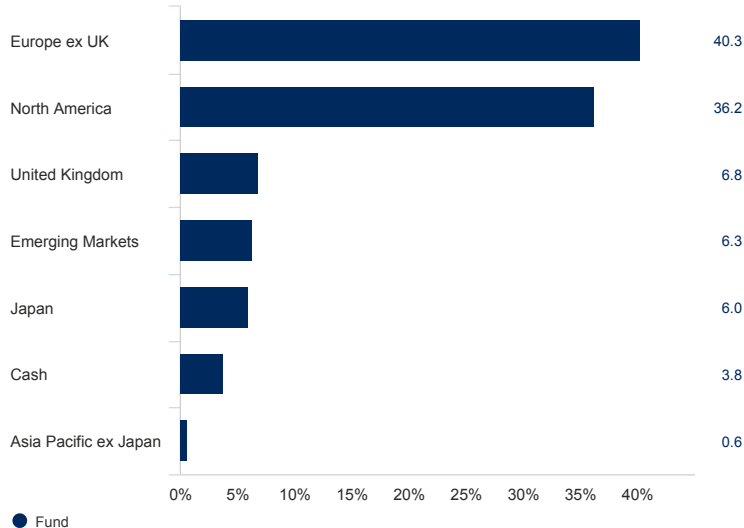

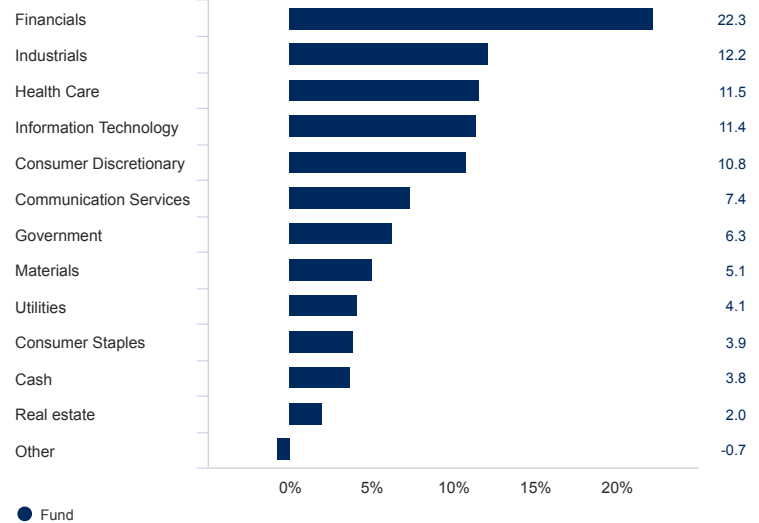
