## Important Information

- The Fund invests in a portfolio of equity or equity related instruments of European companies with an emphasis on larger companies.
- Investors should note the risk of Eurozone crisis, concentration risk of investing in equity or equity related instruments of European companies, currency exchange risk, equities risk, volatility risk, and general investment risk.
- Financial derivative instruments (FDI) may be used for efficient portfolio management purposes or to hedge or reduce the overall risk of investments. - In addition, investors of Monthly Distribution-1 share class that are currency hedged (MD-1 hedged) should be aware of the uncertainty of relative interest rates. The net asset value of the MD-1 hedged may fluctuate and may significantly differ from other share class due to fluctuation of the interest rate differential between the currency in which the MD-1 hedged is denominated and the base currency of the Fund and may result in a greater erosion of capital than other non-hedged share class. - The value of the Fund can be volatile and could go down substantially.
- Investors should not base their investment decision on this material alone.

The Fund aims to provide long-term capital growth by investing in a portfolio of equity or equity related instruments of European companies with an emphasis on larger companies.

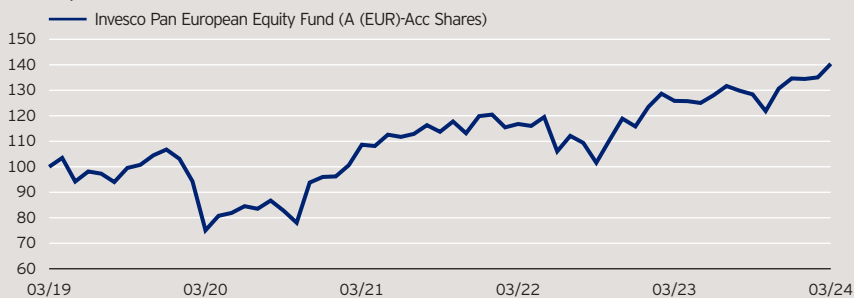
